

Several undergraduates are selected each semester to serve as Undergraduate Teaching Assistants (UTAs) in Department of Chemistry teaching labs. The role of a teaching assistant is to provide support for faculty laboratory course instructors. A UTA will receive financial compensation for the semester and is typically assigned to assist in one 3-hour weekly lab section. Duties will include grading and some lab preparation. Some courses also require UTAs to serve as proctors for quizzes/examinations.

Applicants should complete the form below by **May 11**th to receive full consideration for a Fall UTA position and by **October 31**st for a Spring UTA position. Application can be made for both Fall and Spring semesters by checking both boxes below. Please provide the name of two faculty members that can serve as a reference. Applicants do not need to submit a letter from the faculty, just provide the names. Submit the completed form to the Chemistry Department Office.
